The Technical & Education Council's Water Science and Research Division's Distribution Research Committee in cooperation with the Small System Research Committee and Information Management and Technology Committee have recently completed four 4-minute videos on water sampling in an effort to provide operators with a source of easily-accessible instructional information for review and skills maintenance.
