ACE11 Call for Papers to close September 13

(DENVER, CO) – The [American Water Works Association](http://www.awwa.org) (AWWA) has announced that the 2011 Annual Conference & Exposition (ACE11) Call for Papers will be closing at 11:59 p.m. MDT on Monday, September 13, 2010. Interested individuals should submit abstracts by the deadline.

Submission is open to both members and nonmembers with ideas that will impact the water and wastewater industry. Manufacturers are encouraged to submit abstracts outlining new technology, unique product applications, or equipment of interest to the water community.

Papers for both posters and oral presentations will be included in the conference proceedings, and presenters may apply for free conference registration the day of their presentation.

The presentations selected by AWWA volunteers will comprise the conference professional program of more than 80 half-day sessions. The professional program provides the water community with cutting-edge technical and managerial information. There are sessions designed for utility board members and city council members, personnel directors, public communications managers, customer service professionals and financial managers as well as utility executives and managers, operators, researchers and engineers.

With an expected attendance of 12,000 water professionals, AWWA's annual conference provides the largest and longest-running world water event, offering presenters the opportunity to advance their position as thought leaders and to network with other members of the water community.
